All matriculating JWU graduate students are eligible to apply for participation and earn credit for foundation courses in the Standardized Testing programs. By successfully completing one of the options offered — Challenge or CLEP — students can earn course credit for previous academic and/or prior learning experiences.

**Note:** this brochure is subject to revision at any time.

What do you gain by participating in these programs? You can satisfy your Foundation Course requirements for your program of study.

The following are policies and procedures you should know before taking a Challenge Exam or CLEP Exam.

- The **CLEP exam** requires a passing score of 56 or higher for credit to be awarded.
- You should consult with an academic counselor before applying for any of the exams.
- All exams are for academic credit and they all carry a fee.
- All application and processing fees are non-refundable.
- You must present a valid picture ID when testing.
- After you are determined to be eligible for any standardized exam, you will be notified through JWU e-mail of the time and location of your exam.
- Challenge and CLEP Exams may not be substituted for a class previously failed or one where a withdrawal (W) or a withdrawal/fail (WF) grade has been issued.
- Students cannot apply for a CLEP or Challenge Exam for a class they are currently attending.
- Challenge and CLEP Exams can only be taken during the first term of enrollment.

## STANDARDIZED EXAMS

### College-Level Examination Program Exams (CLEP)

These widely accepted national exams are offered in a variety of subjects. CLEP Exams are treated as transfer credit. All CLEP Exams will be administered on computers. Students may take one exam per test date. **The CLEP exam requires a passing score of 56 or higher for credit to be awarded.**

- **Fees:** All applications must be delivered to the Student Academic Services office along with a \$15 application fee. This non-refundable fee must be paid by check or money order made payable to Johnson & Wales University. The \$77 CLEP fee may be paid at the testing session by credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Discover or JBC [Japanese Bank Card]) or by submitting a check or money order made payable to CLEP. When filling out applications, be sure to list an updated local mailing address as information packets will be sent to you two weeks prior to the exam.

## Challenge Exams

These exams may be taken for specifically designated courses within a department. Because of previous academic and/or work experience, students may request such an exam when they feel they have the knowledge of a specific JWU course. A Challenge Exam that has been failed cannot be repeated.

- **Fees:** There is a \$100 fee for each Challenge Exam taken (per 4.5 credit course), whether or not credits are awarded. This fee includes a \$25 nonrefundable administrative processing fee. All charges are applied directly to the student's account.
