- The Special Honors and Rewards Program (SHARP) is an undergraduate honors program designed for qualified day program students who wish to accelerate their program of study to complete degree requirements in less than the normally required time, which also results in savings of expenses.
- Students accepted into SHARP may register for up to 25.0 quarter credit hours per term with no additional fee.
- Students who are denied or become ineligible for SHARP may not reapply (eligibility is lost permanently).

If accepted into SHARP, you understand the following.

- In order to remain eligible for SHARP, you must maintain full-time enrollment and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.40 at the end of each term.
- It is at your discretion to register additional credits; course registration is limited to space and availability, and preferred scheduling and graduation acceleration cannot be guaranteed.
- The benefits of SHARP may not be applied during full-time internship term or toward any independent study course.
- Failure to maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.40 or better after each term will cause you to become permanently ineligible for the benefits provided by SHARP (the only exception to this policy is the first term of enrollment, during which the cumulative GPA may be less than 3.40).
- If you lose SHARP eligibility, you will be billed an additional charge if you are registered for more than 21 credits (it is your responsibility to adjust your schedule if you do not want to incur additional charges to your account).
