Burglary

On November 17, 2009 at approximately 4:00 p.m., the North Miami Police Department alerted Campus Safety & Security of a Black Male subject that had fled from police and was last seen entering the Biscayne Commons Fitness Building. A timely warning was issued to resident students using the emergency notification system advising them to remain inside their rooms or seek shelter on a nearby university facility. The assailant was taken into custody by the North Miami Police Department after locating him inside room 212 of the Biscayne Commons Residence Hall that is currently under construction.
