Motor Vehicle Theft

On November 17, 2009 at approximately 7:15 p.m., a student reported that his motorcycle (2002 yellow/black Honda CBR F4) was stolen from a public street in front of the University Library. The student parked the bike at 1 p.m. and discovered that the motorcycle was missing at 7 p.m. North Miami Police Department was contacted for further investigation.

Crime Prevention Tip:

- Make sure lock all doors or tires to your personal or university vehicles
- Park in well-lighted areas and always lock your vehicle.
- Always check for intruders inside your vehicle (front and back seats) before climbing in.
- Never leave a purse, packages or valuables such as electronics in plain view inside your vehicle; if possible, lock items in your trunk.
- Report all suspicious activity or person(s) immediately by calling 305-892-7011 or use nearby a blue light phone (24 hours a day)
