**EARLY ACTION ADMISSION (FIRST-YEAR APPLICANTS FOR FALL TERM):** Johnson & Wales University offers Early Action Admission, a non-binding application program for students who view JWU as one of their top choice schools. The advantage of Early Action is that applicants will learn of their admission decision sooner for planning purposes. Along with a decision letter, the applicant will receive scholarship notification (if applicable).

The application deadline for Early Action is November 1. Early Action decisions will be released beginning November 15. Application and transcripts must be received by the deadline. Candidates for Early Action will be evaluated primarily on their high school record through their junior year. Students who apply but do not meet the deadline will be placed in the regular (rolling) admission applicant pool.

**ROLLING ADMISSION (ALL TERMS):** Rolling Admission offers JWU applicants a deadline-free application and decision process. Applications for the Fall Term received after November 1 will be reviewed on a rolling basis; Admissions will begin releasing decisions on December 15. Students are encouraged to complete the application process as soon as possible.
