Chancellor John J. Bowen '77

In January 2018, Chancellor John J. Bowen announced his retirement from Johnson & Wales University at the end of the 2018 calendar year, bringing to a close a tenure where he has been at the forefront of the transformation of JWU into the pioneering educational institution it is today.

Chancellor Bowen's impacts on the university are immeasurable. He helped guide the university's development of culinary arts education as a faculty member, director and dean. He reaffirmed the university's focus on career education by establishing what is today known as Experiential Education & Career Services.

As vice president of administration, executive vice president, president of the Providence Campus, university president, chief executive officer and chancellor, he has implemented a vision for the growth of JWU and its Downcity and Harborside communities. One of Chancellor Bowen's proudest accomplishments is the establishment of the Chancellor's Student Relief Fund, which provides support for students facing unexpected financial needs in emergency situations so they can continue pursuing their dream of a Johnson & Wales education.

On the occasion of his announcement, Chair of the JWU Board of Trustees James H. Hance Jr. '06 Hon., wrote to the JWU community:

"On behalf of the Board of Trustees, we acknowledge Chancellor John Bowen's announcement of his intent to retire at the end of 2018. We wish to express our gratitude for his 45 years of extraordinary dedication and service to Johnson & Wales University. His accomplishments during his time are numerous and impactful.

"Johnson & Wales has transformed under John's leadership in many vital ways. He has made complicated and bold decisions in the best interest of our university. **FOCUS 2011** was an ambitious plan that launched Johnson & Wales into uncharted areas. John and his team deftly recognized the need to address many issues such as affordability and retention efforts ahead of many of our peers. Through thoughtful and deliberate planning, he has moved this university in new directions, most recently health sciences, always with the intent to provide our students with better professional and personal lives. In September 2016, we recognized and celebrated his leadership with the dedication of the John J. Bowen Center for Science and Innovation – a fitting tribute to his more than four decades of service to the students, faculty and staff of Johnson & Wales."

The JWU community thanks Chancellor Bowen for his inspiring 45 years of dedication to Johnson & Wales University and extends its congratulations and best wishes to First Lady Kathleen Harney and Chancellor Bowen as they prepare for the next chapter in their lives.

A born and raised Rhode Islander, Marissa Ann Mayo has been a role model student making the most of her JWU education. She enrolled in September 2013 and graduated in November 2016 with a bachelor's degree in Sports/Entertainment/Event Management with a concentration in Sales and Marketing.

Six months after enrolling for a bachelor's degree, Mayo became a student assistant to Graduate Studies, a job she continued as she pursued her MBA. She joined the JWU Special Events Society and in 2015 began blogging for the College of Online Education. That same year, she co-founded Project HEAL (Help to Eat, Accept and Live), a nonprofit dedicated to eating disorder awareness and recovery.

While a student, Mayo worked as an event coordinator for URI's iCubed, a marketing event manager for the Central Rhode Island Chamber of Commerce, and an assistant event coordinator for Hillside Country Club. Since June 2015, she has been a per-diem sales and promotion liquor model for Next Level Marketing, imparting her brand knowledge to customers. After receiving her bachelor's degree, she became a special event assistant at Dave & Busters. Currently, she is an accounts payable coordinator at CVS Health.

A self-described coffee addict and nutrition fanatic, Mayo is a certified personal trainer who enjoys bodybuilding, yoga, kickboxing, Zumba or any form of a good workout. In her free time, she enjoys the beach in the summer, hiking, photography, reading and writing.

DIANE D'AMBRA, M.S., SPHR, SHRM-SCP

Vice President of Human Resources, Johnson & Wales University

Diane D'Ambra is an accomplished human resources professional with extensive senior-level experience in all aspects of human resources including strategic planning, organizational development, employee relations, compensation, benefits, recruitment, performance management, development and training, and regulatory compliance. A Johnson & Wales alumna, she holds a master's degree in Human Resource Development from Villanova University and earned her senior professional in human resources (SPHR) certification from the HR Certification Institute as well as senior certified professional (SHRM-SCP) certification from the Society for Human Resource Management.

D'Ambra began her career at the university in 1983 when she worked as a payroll assistant. After seven years in that role, she transitioned to assistant director of payroll & personnel where she redesigned the employee health insurance benefits program, combining eight regional plans into one comprehensive national plan. She also restructured the student employment programs to give students more meaningful work opportunities.

D'Ambra was instrumental in establishing JWU's human resources structure and in 2000, was promoted to director of human resources. In this position, she helped build consistent standards of excellence universitywide by creating and implementing the JWU Employee Competency Model. During that time, she also redesigned the employee retirement benefit which has resulted in a successful program with 97 percent employee participation.

In her current role as vice president of human resources, D'Ambra is a member of the president's senior management team. She provides strategic human resources leadership for a multi-state, multi-campus system with more than 2,000 employees and 14,000 students while leading 30-plus staff members.

JOSEPH R. BERETTA

Doctor of Business Administration

Joseph R. Beretta is president and chief financial officer of The Robinson Green Beretta (RGB) Corporation, one of Rhode Island's most prestigious architectural, engineering and interior design firms. Beretta joined RGB as a controller in 1973 upon receiving a business bachelor's degree from Norwich University. Five years later, he attained an MBA from Bryant University, and was named president and chief financial officer in the late 1990s. His primary responsibilities include managing accounting, administration and human resources. He is also actively involved with business and client development and maintaining client relationships.

RGB has a long history of service to the major corporations and critical government agencies of southern New England. Past projects have included the Foundry Complex, the T.F. Green Airport Interlink and Skywalk, Citizens One Plaza, and Johnson & Wales' Wildcat Center and Harbor View properties. Under Beretta's leadership, RGB also worked on the 1980 Winter Olympic village in Lake Placid, New York.

Beretta's civic engagement includes service on the boards and committees of numerous nonprofit organizations and local businesses. He has been a member of the corporation of Johnson & Wales University since 2011, a trustee of the Providence Foundation since 2001, and a president's council member of La Salle Academy since 2009. He is also a board member of the Greater Providence Chamber of Commerce and Navigant Credit Union, where he was a board chair from 2014 to 2017. He was president of Metacomet Country Club as well as Beneficent House, which provides housing to people who cannot afford rent.

Beretta regularly donates to hospitals, organizations that fight pancreatic cancer, nonprofits that help those with developmental disabilities, and the Johnson & Wales University Chancellor's Relief Fund. His generosity has helped 1,100 Cub and Boy Scouts attend summer camp for free. Beretta's hard work and community service serve as an inspiration for RGB employees; his intern architects mentor middle and high school students who are considering a career in construction, engineering or architecture.

Beretta's hobbies include travel, including regular trips to Aruba and Florida, among other destinations, and golf, including playing in charity golf tournaments. He lives in Lincoln, Rhode Island.

LAURA FREID, ED.D.

Doctor of Business Administration

Laura Freid, president of Maine College of Art (MECA), has pursued a career in higher education and the arts, topics that were featured in her previous positions in journalism and film.

Prior to becoming the leader of MECA in 2017, Freid spent 12 years as CEO and executive director of Silkroad, a cross-cultural arts organization founded by world-famous cellist Yo-Yo Ma. She initiated the organization's ongoing multi-year affiliation with Harvard University, a five-year partnership with the Rhode Island School of Design, and created the first joint venture with the Harvard Business School.

During her tenure, Silkroad spearheaded a yearlong, citywide celebration of the arts in Chicago; focused on the arts and passion-driven learning in work with middle schools, educators and teaching artists; and brought together artists and business leaders to influence the emerging field of cultural entrepreneurship, in which artists learn how to package and present their art to achieve a successful living.

Strengthening her skill for storytelling through media, Freid served as executive producer of the 2016 internationally acclaimed feature documentary "The Music of Strangers: Yo-Yo Ma and the Silk Road Ensemble."

Prior to joining Silkroad, Freid was executive vice president for public affairs and university relations at Brown University. A magazine journalist and editor, she served as publisher of *Harvard Magazine* and publisher and editor of *Bostonia* magazine.

Freid received an undergraduate degree from Washington University in St. Louis, an MBA from Boston University, and an Ed.D. from the University of Pennsylvania. She has served as a trustee of Johnson & Wales University since 2009.

Freid and her husband live in Portland, Maine, with their standard poodle, Alto.

Symbols of Commencement

UNIVERSITY SEAL

The university seal represents Johnson & Wales University's roots. The year at the top of the shield, 1914, is the year that the university was founded by Gertrude I. Johnson and Mary T. Wales. The dragon of St. George on the upper portion of the crest honors the Wales family, while the lower portion of the crest bears the cross of St. John and honors the Johnson family.

MACE

The Johnson & Wales University mace symbolizes the ideals and values of JWU's educational philosophy. Cast of silver and bronze, it is engraved with the names of our founders and presidents, past and present. Our campus locations are engraved on the golden bands. On ceremonial occasions, university officials carry the mace to display the unity and continuity of Johnson & Wales University.

The mace dates to medieval times, when it was first used as a weapon. Forbidden to use swords, medieval European bishops were allowed to enter battle with a mace — typically an iron or steel club designed to split armor. By the 16th century, the mace had become a symbol of authority that colleges and universities began using ceremonially. That tradition continues today, and the mace is carried as part of formal academic occasions like these at colleges and universities across the globe.

ACADEMIC DRESS

The tradition of wearing distinctive dress for academic reasons dates back to the Middle Ages. Today, academic costumes are usually worn in the United States by people participating in academic ceremonies.

The faculty and platform party wear regalia representative of the degrees they possess.

HOODS

Originating from the cowls of monastic orders, the hoods are the most distinctive part of the academic regalia. Their shape and size indicate the level of degree attained, and the colors reflect both the academic field as well as the institution that granted the degree.

CAPS

There is more variety in the shape and color of academic hats than in any other area. Master's and doctoral degree recipients wear the tassel on the left throughout the ceremony, and the doctoral soft-cap often features a gold tassel.
